Coaches' Representatives Meeting, Saturday, April 12, 2014

Basketball Coaches

Representatives, Adam Priefer, Centerville High School; Kris Spriggs, Kenton Ridge

Concerns:

3. Diving. Take 32 to Districts instead of 24.
4. All Districts across state compete on same day.

6. Divers must compete in eleven dive meets before sectionals.
7. Running the District meet as a boy and girl meet, allowing more rest time in-between.
8. Relay. Take off judging in District meet. We outdid other districts in DQs.
